Hon. Speaker: Hon. Members, allow me to recognize the presence of the following people: we have the Andiegos here; Mrs. Milka Andiego, wherever you are. In the exercise of powers conferred in the article 88 (4) 98 (1) 194 (1) of the Constitution of Kenya section 4 of the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission Act 2011 section 16, 19, 38 and 39 and the regulations there in; the commission declares that the persons listed in columns 1 and 2 of the first and second schedule here under were elected as Members of the Senate Migori County and County Assembly Member for Central Sakwa Ward in Siaya County Assembly respectively.

Having received the majority of the votes cast in the by election held on the 8th October, 2018 and complied with the provision of the Constitution, the elections Act 2011, elections general regulations 2012.

I will not read the one for Migori; I will go straight to the one for Siaya that the person elected as Member of Central Sakwa Ward, Siaya County is Andiego Charlton Odhiambo, County code 41 and County name Siaya Constituency code 236, Constituency name Bondo and the County Assembly Ward name is Central Sakwa, the County Assembly Ward code is 1176, the party name is Orange Democratic Movement abbreviated as ODM, the symbol is orange and votes garnered in figures is 3,816, signed by W.W. Chebukati, Chairperson.
