**Hon. Oor:** I wish to give a notice of the following Motion;

Aware That: the County Government of Siaya allocated Kshs. 17 billion as emergency funds to address any unforeseen disaster in the County Budget estimates for 2019/2020.

Further aware that: the long rains have been too heavy causing many rivers and water bodies to burst their boundaries and wreak havoc both economically and socially.

Noting that most families have been adversely affected and displaced by floods from their homes and are currently seeking shelter in churches, schools and some are residing beside the road.

Noting that the displaced people are in dire need of humanitarian assistance both financially and materially especially at this time when the County is also faced by Covid-19 pandemic.

Further aware that the County Government has started distributing food and other basic needs to victims in some parts of the County.
