ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

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AN ACT of the County Assembly of Siaya to provide for revenue raising measures, imposition of fees and charges for the County Government of Siaya; and for matters incidental thereto

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Siaya as follows—

PART I—PRELIMINARY

1. This Act may be cited as the Siaya County Finance Bill, 2023 and shall come into operation on such date as the County Executive Committee Member responsible for Finance, with the concurrence of the Governor, may appoint a date and different dates may be appointed for different provisions.

Short title and Commencement

2. This Act prescribes the rates of taxes and charges for the assessment year 2021-2022, the rates at which taxes and other charges will be payable during the financial year 2022-2023 from properties which include land and buildings, businesses, markets, agricultural produce, outdoor advertisement, health services, vehicle parking, heritage sites, County parks, entertainment and extraction activities.

Object and Purpose of act

3. Interpretation: -

Interpretation

(1) Cess; means tax or fees chargeable on certain goods specified under various schedule in this Act and shall include a special levy on value added products to promote the growth of the industry, factories and shall include but is not limited to factory cess, mining cess and sand cess;

(2) Authorized Channel; means any channel legally permitted by the County Government of Siaya in its dealings and service provisions

(3) County Revenue Collector; means the county public officer appointed pursuant to section 158 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 for the purpose of collecting revenue for the County Government and remitting it to the County Receiver of Revenue

(4) County Government; means the County Government of Siaya

(5) County Receiver of Revenue; in relation to the county government, means a person designated to be a receiver of revenue under section 157 of the PFM Act 2012;

(6) County Executive Committee Member; means the member of a County Executive Committee responsible for the financial affairs of the County and for the County Treasury.

(7) “Contributions in lieu of rates (CILOR)” means a charge payable by National Government Agencies to County Government of Siaya for spaces they occupy;

(8) “Revenue Director” means overall officer in charge of a revenue directorate in the County

(9) “Municipality Revenue Officer” means officer in charge of revenue mobilization and collection within any Municipality within the County

(10) “Sub-County Revenue Officer” means officer in charge of revenue mobilization; collection and management at any subcounty within the County

(11) “Jua-Kali” Shall only refer to Carpentry, Metal Workshops and Tin Smiths under the Umbrella of Kenya Industrial Estates (K.I.E) housed in the Kenya Industrial Estates (K.I.E) Shades.

(12) “License” shall refer to Authorization for any person to conduct a particular business or line business within a certain jurisdiction within the County.

(13) “Permit” shall refer to license granted or issued by the County Government of Siaya to any business operating within Siaya County

4. In this Bill unless the context otherwise requires—

(1) The revenue raising measures of the county government relating to property rates and all charges in the department of Lands, Physical Planning, Survey and Housing are set out in First Schedule.

Property rates

(2) The revenue raising measures in the county government relating to trade license fees are set out in Second Schedule. Trade licenses

(3) The revenue raising measures in the County government relating to fees and charges for services are set out in the Third Schedule. Other charges

5. The revenue raising measures of the County Government provided for in this Bill do not in any way prejudice National Economic Policies, economic activities across county boundaries or the National mobility of goods, services, capital or Labour.

6. If any National Bill mentioned in Schedule 3 has not been amended to provide for the imposition of fees or charges for services by the county government, then item 7 of the Sixth schedule of the Constitution, applies in relation to that Bill.

7. To avoid doubt, nothing in this Bill is taken to prevent the county government from entering into a contract or agreement or other arrangement to provide a service upon payment of a fee or charge.

PART II — RATES APPLICABLE, TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES –PAYABLE

8. (1) The Rates, Taxes, Fees and Charges set out in the “New Charges” column of the schedule shall apply for the respective items listed in the “Item Description” column at the rate set out therein. Charges

(2) For greater certainty, the rates, taxes, fees and charges applicable are payable to the County Government of Siaya at the commencement of this Bill, but which are not included in the schedule to this Bill, shall continue to apply under the existing by-laws of the defunct Siaya Municipal Council, Siaya County Council, Bondo Town Council, Yala Town Council, Ugunja Town Council and Ukwala Town Council until such by-laws are specifically repealed or replaced by County Government of Siaya Legislation.

9. (1) All directions, resolutions, orders, authorizations and provisions that are Contained in the Siaya County Revenue Administration Act, 2014, Single Business Permits Regulations, Siaya County Trade License Act, 2014 & Public Finance Management Act, 2015 (Revised) and other related laws and subsidiary legislations that are concerned with the revenue administration in the county shall be deemed to be part of this Bill. Licenses,
Permit and
Permit Fees.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to the specific respective amounts payable in respect of the rates, taxes, fees, charges or other levies and, in that regard, the amount provided shall be applicable as provided for in the “New Charges” columns in the Schedule.

10. (1) A person shall not carry out any business or service within the County without a valid license or permit issued by the relevant County Office. General Fees

(2) A person who intends to carry out any of the businesses listed in the or under the schedule of the single business permit regulation shall apply for a license or permit from the relevant County offices or such other designated agents as shall be prescribed by the County Government from time to time.

(3) A person who applies for license under subsection (2) shall be issued with a license on the payment of the applicable fee, depending on the location and size of the business as specified in the schedule or the single business permit regulation.

(4) Licenses and permits issued under subsection (3) must be visibly displayed in its original form at the business premise at all times.

(5) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence.

11. (1) A person occupying any plot, stall or house leased or rented out by the County Government shall pay rent or rates, whichever is applicable, at the rate specified in Plot & House
Rent

the Schedule.

(2) A penalty of three percent per month shall be charged for any amount of rent or rates for a plot that remains unpaid for after the 31st day of March Yearly.

(3) A person who contravenes the provisions of subsection (1) may be evicted in accordance with existing legislations on evictions if he or she fails to pay house rent for three consecutive months.

(4) The County Government shall repossess the Plot, stall or house if a person fails to pay the rent or rates, whichever is applicable for more than one year.

12. (1) Cess or market fee shall be charged on the goods specified in Schedule 3.

Cess & Market
Fees.

(2) There shall be established a levy on Murram, Hardcore, and Royalties to be effected at source. This Levy shall be paid by the Transporter.

(3) A person who fails to pay, evades a barrier, Check point or hinders an authorized person from Collecting cess or market fee set under this schedule commits an offence.

(4) "Entry Fee" in this context shall refer to levies charged on cess from other counties on transit through Siaya County

13. (1) All persons operating single business permits shall be required to pay the relevant licenses, fees and charges set under Schedule 2 and the single business permit Regulations.

General

(2) Any person operating a business who fails to pay the said fees, charges or license set under Schedule 2 and the single business permit regulations commits an offence.

(3) Business permits shall not be issued for businesses being carried out in a building where land and ground rent are owing.

(4) A permit fee shall be paid to the County which maybe revised from time to time.

(5) A permit maybe transferred by the holder to any person with prior consent of the county, accompanied by a fee which is subjected to revision from time to time.

(6) Any person authorized by the County Director of Enforcement may enter any premises at any time to inspect or inquire if the condition attached to the permit are being observed. Anyone who interferes shall be guilty of an offense.

(7) Every applicant for a single business permit shall produce the Previous years for proof of payment and rates of the county where applicable

(8) If any permit contravenes any of the conditions set out by County, the County may refuse to grant or renew it.

(9) All business premises shall be required to be painted prior to issuance of single business permits; failure shall result in a fine being levied.

14. (1) The County Executive Committee Member for Finance may by order published in the gazette amend any additional fees, tax, license, cess and fees schedules to supplement the current schedule.

(2) Any order made under subsection (1) shall be laid before the County Assembly without unreasonable delay, and unless a resolution approving the order is passed by the County Assembly within Twenty-one days when the Assembly next sits after the order is so laid, the order shall lapse, but without prejudice to anything previously done there under.

PART III — PAYMENT

15. (1) All payments to the County Government made under this Bill shall be paid through an authorized channel.

(2) A County Revenue Collector authorized by the County Government to collect revenue shall have an identification card issued by the County Government which shall be worn visibly by such County Revenue Collector.

(3) An official receipt shall be issued for all payments made to the County Government.

(4) Every person who makes a payment through an authorized channel shall demand an official receipt for each such payment and every payment made through an authorized channel shall be evidenced by an official receipt.

(5) A person shall not receive or collect any money on behalf of the County Government unless he or she has been appointed to do so or has authority as the receiver and collector of County Government Revenue.

(6) A person who contravenes the provisions of this section commits an offence,

16. (1) The County Executive Committee Member for Finance may by written notice addressed to any person—

an agent

(a) Designate any person to be an agent of the County Government for the purposes of the collection or recovery of charges, permit fees, license fees, rent, cess and such other fees as may be necessary for carrying out the purpose of this Act; and

(b) Specify the amount of charges, permit fees, license fees, rent, cess and such other fees to be collected or recovered by the agent.

(2) An agent appointed under this section shall enforce and ensure due compliance with the provisions of this Bill and shall remit all revenue collected to the County Government through the County Receiver of Revenue or as may be otherwise instructed in the appointment notice.

(3) Where an agent claims to be, or to have become unable to comply with subsection (2), such agent shall, within seven working days, notify the County Executive Committee Member in writing, setting out fully the reasons for his inability to comply, and the County Executive Committee Member shall accept the notification and cancel or amend the appointment notice accordingly.

(4) Unless and until a notification is given by an agent under subsection (3), sufficient moneys for the payment of charges, permit fees, license fees, rent, cess and such other fees specified in the agent's appointment notice shall be presumed to be held by him or her and this money shall be and payable to the County Government.

(5) For the purposes of this section, the County Executive Committee Member of Finance may, by notice in writing, at any time, require any person to furnish him or her, within reasonable time not being less than seven days from the date of service of the notice, with information showing any moneys which may be held by the agent for, or due by him to the County Government.

(6) Where an agent fails to pay an amount of money collected under this section within the time specified in the notice, the provisions of this Bill relating to the collection and recovery of that amount as if it were tax due and payable by the agent, the due date for the payment of which was the date upon which that amount should have been paid to the County Government under this subsection.

(7) An agent who makes payment to the County Government under this section shall for all purposes be deemed to have acted under the authority of the County Government and shall be indemnified in respect of that payment against all proceedings, civil or criminal, and all processes, judicial or extra-judicial, notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary in any written law contract or agreement.

(8) Any person who willfully makes any false or misleading statement, or willfully conceals any material fact shall be guilty of an offence.

(9) All practitioners not licensed by their various bodies shall be expected to pay Single Business Permit as per the County Government Regulations

PART IV- ACCOUNTABILITY AND TRANSPARENCY

17. a) The executive Member for finance shall assign targets on revenue collections on the Sub-counties and Municipalities

b) It shall constitute an offence for any revenue officer to divert, or incur financial loss due to dishonesty, incompetence or malpractice for money received as revenue from the public for the county government

c) To protect its revenue bases, the Executive Committee Member for Finance shall take up the Existing Revenue collection centers already in the Sub-Counties and Municipalities with such modifications as may be deemed necessary.

d) There shall be established Revenue Collection Centers within the Sub-Counties and Municipalities headed by Revenue Officer who shall report to the Director Revenue who will report directly to the Chief officer.

e) The Revenue officer /and Revenue collector shall be held liable for any loss, stolen or unauthorized spending of revenue or and any such money held by the officer

f) The Department have a responsibility to;

- I. Identify Revenue Streams for purposes of increasing the tax base;
- II. Come up with Rules and Regulations to support revenue collection;
- III. Ensure that services incidental to Revenue Collection have been rendered.

PART V — OFFENCES AND PENALTIES

18. Any person who commits an offence under this Bill for which no penalty is provided shall be liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding Kenya Shillings Two hundred thousand (200,000) or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both.

19. A member of staff of the County Government or any other person having a duty to perform under this Bill who—

- (a) makes, in any record, or document required to be kept or made by that person, an entry which he or she knows or has reasonable cause to believe not to be true or to be false;
- (b) willfully refuses to do anything which he or she knows or has reasonable cause to believe not to be true or to be false;
- (c) interferes with any other person or process under this Bill, so as to defeat the provisions, requirements or purposes of this Bill;
- (d) Where required under this Bill to do anything to give effect to the provisions of this Bill, fails to do such thing;

- (e) Without reasonable cause omits to do something in breach of his or her duty under this Bill;
- (f) Willfully contravenes the provisions of this Bill to give undue advantage or favor to another person;

(g) Fails to prevent or report to the County Government or any other relevant authority, the commission of an offence committed under this Bill;

Commits an offence and is liable on conviction, to a fine not exceeding Kenya Shillings two hundred thousand (200,000) or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both.

(h) Staffs who operate businesses but fail to pay for their Single Business Permits shall be subjected to a penalty of one and half ($1\frac{1}{2}$) times the normal payment rate recoverable from their payrolls

20. (i) All Passenger Service Vehicles (P.S.V) To and From Kisumu shall access the Bus park using Nyadorera-Kisumu Highway, those To and From Ugunja to branch off at Kenya Medical Training College (K.M.T.C) via Stadium road. All PSV's are Prohibited from the Town Centre and shall not be allowed to use the Roads in front of the County Headquarters, County Assembly, The Law Courts, Commercial Bank, Co-Operative Bank and Huduma Centre . Any person who Contravenes this bill commits an offence and shall be liable to payment of(Kshs 50,000) Fifty Thousands Shillings) fine or imprisonment for one year or both.

(ii) Buses and Shuttles' that have offices within the CBD shall access their offices to and From Kisumu by Turning off at Shell Filling Station and Join Central Primary School Road, Turn on Hospital Road past Kenya Medical Training College (KMTC) onto A.C.K Cathedral Stretch, Turn Right onto the Road Leading to Kenya Commercial Bank and proceed to their respective offices.

21. No Omnibus when carrying passengers for hire or reward shall without the express authority of the Director of revenue or Enforcement Inspectorate, start or terminate at any place other than the Omnibus Park . No person shall drop or pick passengers within a radius of 300 Meters within the Town apart from the designated areas. Any contravention of this law shall be liable to payment of a fine of Kenya Shillings Four Thousands(4,000),or imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both

22. No person shall Hoot, Bang the omnibus body, make Noise, Disturb piece in any manner or Tout in any form while in the vicinity of the County and Sub-County Headquarters, Assembly, The Law Courts and Hospitals, any contravention of this law shall be liable to payment of a fine of Kshs 10,000 (Ten Thousand), or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both.

23. i) Any motor vehicle that fails to pay park entry fee prescribed in the bus Park fees and charges shall have such vehicles Clamped and towed away a fine of Thirty Thousand Shillings (Kshs 30,000) shall be levied or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both.

ii) When any motor vehicle fails to pay for entry fee and such vehicle is Impounded and clamped the owner shall be expected to pay Kenya Shillings Five Thousand and Fifty (5,050) and Clamping Fee of Kenya Shillings of Thirty Thousand (30,000)

iii) Independent Towing trucks operating within the jurisdiction of the County Government area must be licensed by the National Transport and Safety Authority (NTSA) and County Government single business permit for transport.

iv) When an impounded vehicle is being towed County enforcement officers shall be

expected be present in full uniform and their name tags conspicuously displayed at all times during the operation.

24 Any vehicle /Motor Cycle/ Bicycle riding or Parking on Non- motorized walkways shall be Clamped/impounded, a fine of Fifteen Thousand Kshs15,000) shall be Levied on Motor Vehicles, Motor Cycles Three Thousand (Kshs 3,000) and One Thousand (Kshs 1,000) Bicycles respectively for such an offence or imprisonment for a term not exceeding Six months or both. Damaging of Walk Ways

25. Any individual whose Motor Vehicle is Clamped and such an individual proceeds to remove a Clamp without the Authority of an Authorized officer shall be deemed to have Committed an offence , and shall be fined Thirty Thousand Shillings (30,000) or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding Three years or both. Damaging of Clamp(s)

26. Any individual or institution that Dumps refuse in an undesignated place shall be liable to a fine of Fifty Thousand Shillings(50,000), or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both. Dumping of garbage

27. Any individual who shall be found to have damaged any property in the Bus Park, Governors park, Ahindi Garden or any other County property for that matter, shall have Committed an offence and shall pay a fine of at least Five Thousand Shillings (Kshs 5,000) for repair of such damages. Damage to Property

28. No individual, Organization/Group shall without the Rightful Authority of the County Directors of Enforcement and Revenue Block a public Road for any Sporting activity, without payment of the requisite fee.

29. (i) Persons living with disability (PWD's) liable to County taxes, licenses, fees and charges may apply to the County Executive Committee Member responsible for Finance for exemption, of a $\frac{1}{3}$ of all levies, except rates. PWD's

(ii) The County Executive Committee Member responsible for Finance shall, in consultation with the Department, assess all applications received under Sub Section (1) and make such order thereon, if any, as he deems fit, exempting the applicant wholly, or to the extent provided by the order, from County Taxes, licenses, fees and Charges specified therein, and any such order shall, notwithstanding the provisions of any other Act, have effect according to its terms. This Section shall not apply to controlled Liquor licenses and any other licenses dealing in a controlled business thereof.

30. Every business shall pay a fee of Kshs 1000 for Trade Name Annually.

31. All Sub-County Offices/Compounds will be Gazetted Impounding Areas

32. Any individual or institution that shall be deemed to have obstructed County officers from carrying out their duties, will have committed an offence and shall be liable to a fine of Kenya Shillings Three Hundred Thousand (300,000) or imprisonment to a period not exceeding Twenty-Four Months (24 Months) imprisonment or both

33. It shall be responsibility of the Directorate of Revenue and County Enforcement to set up designated boda boda stages. Contravention of this regulation by any Boda Boda Group shall attract a fine of Kenya Shillings Fifty Thousand (Kshs 50,000) or a term of Two years imprisonment or both.

34. Any individual or Firm that shall leave a quarry site without restoration to original form shall be liable to a fine of Kenya Shillings Fifty Thousand (50,000) or Imprisonment for a period of one year or both.

35. Any person found pulling or pushing any materials in a manner likely to cause damage to

road or any road furniture shall have committed an offence and be liable to a fine of Keny Shillings One Thousand (Kshs 1,000) or imprisonment to a term of six months or both.

PART VI — MISCELLANEOUS

36. (1) Any charges, permit fees, license fees, rent, cess and such other fees payable to the County Government at the commencement of this Bill by any business operating within the county which are not included in any of the Schedules to this Bill, shall continue to be chargeable by, and payable to the County Government unless they are repealed by a Bill of the County Government or until a Bill of the County Government on such charges, permit fees, license fees, rent, cess and such other fees is enacted.

Savings

(2) All businesses within the jurisdiction of the County shall be required to pay licenses, charges, fees, cess, rent or other prescribed fees unless specifically exempted by any relevant legislation or authority.

(3) All levies, charges, tax, cess and licenses that were payable under the repealed Local Government Act shall continue to be paid and administered under this Bill: provided that this sub-section also apply to such fees and charges levied by various ministries and departments of the national government in respect of function devolved to the county governments under part 2 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya which fees and charges shall be levied by the County Government on transfer of the devolved functions.

37. Unless otherwise provided in this Bill, the rates for fees, charges, licenses, cess or rent, applicable before the commencement of this Bill in respect of any business, activity, goods or services listed in the schedules, shall cease to apply.

Cessation

38. The County Executive Committee Member may make regulations for the better carrying out of the purposes and provisions of this Bill.

ITEM 1 — AMOUNT OF RATES

Pursuant to Section 3 and Section 8 of the Rating Act Cap 267 of 1986(Revised 2012), the amount of a rate payable to the county government in respect of a ratable property for 2022/2023 is 10% of the unimproved site value of the ratable property.

ITEM 2 – WAIVER

Pursuant to 16(2) of the Rating Act (Cap. 267) of 1986 (Revised, 2012), a waiver of 2% is payable on any rate on or before the due date.

ITEM 3 – INTEREST

Pursuant to section 16(3) and (4) of the Rating Act Cap 267 of 1986(Revised 2012), interest at the rate of 3% per month is payable to the county government on any rate that remains unpaid after 31st March.

COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF SIAYA (SINGLE BUSINESS PERMIT)

REGULATIONS, 2023

1. These rules may be cited as the (Single Business Permit) Rules, 2023.
2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires— “Single business permit” means a permit issued by Siaya County Government under Siaya Revenue Administration Act 2023
3. These Rules shall apply to all Sub-counties of Siaya County Government
4. Where a person is issued with a Single Business Permit by one Sub-County of Siaya County Government, such permit shall be valid for the distribution of goods or provision of services within the area of any other Sub-County within Siaya County Government provided the right charge has been levied.

5. The form of registration for a Single Business Permit shall be in such form as the County may, from time to time, prescribe.

6 (1) The fees payable in respect of a Single Business Permit in respect of the various classes of Various Trading Center shall be as set out in the Schedule.

(2) The fees specified in the Schedule shall be applicable as follows—

(a) for Municipalities, columns, 8, 9 and 10;

(b) for Category Two Centers, columns 5, 6, and 7;

(c) for Other Trading Centers, columns, 1, 2, 3, and 4.

(3) No Sub -County may base its fees and charges on a range which is higher than that specified for it in the Schedule.

(4) Notwithstanding paragraph (3), a Sub-County may base its fees and charges within the Three (3) ranges which are specified within the Schedule.

(5) Any Sub-County which, on the date of coming into operation of these Rules, has been Charging fees and charges at a range which is higher/Lower than that specified in the Schedule shall adopt the charges specified therein at the beginning of the financial year beginning on the 1st July next following that date.

7. (1) Siaya County Government may select the appropriate range of fees to impose on business within its jurisdiction depending on the class under which it falls as indicated in the Schedule.

(2) Siaya County Government shall, upon selecting a range of fees and charges as provided in paragraph (1), impose its fees and charges in amounts only within that range.

8. The selection of a range of fees and charges as required under these Rules shall be preceded by Public Participation held by the Siaya County Government with stakeholders within its area of jurisdiction in the manner specified in Rule 9.

9. (1) Where Siaya County Government intends to adopt or change a range of fees and charges, it shall publish a notice of the intention to do so—

(a) in a newspaper of wide circulation in its area of jurisdiction;

(b) on a conspicuous part of its Sub Counties notice boards; and

(c) in any other manner so as to bring it to the attention of the business community and stakeholders.

(2) The notice under paragraph (1) shall contain—

(a) the proposed fees and charges and the Previous charges;

(b) an invitation to stakeholders to Participate the Public Participation; and

(c) the date, venue and time of a consultative forum which shall be held to discuss the proposed fees and charges.

10. (1) Siaya County Government shall forward its proposed new fees and charges to the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) Finance and Economic Planning for forwarding to the County Assembly Legal and Administration Committee for unparking, discussion and approval after the conclusion of the consultative process set out in rules 8 & 9

(2) The County Assembly may approve the proposals forwarded where it is satisfied, that the Finance and Economic Planning, Directorate of Revenue has observed all the procedures prescribed under these Rules.

11. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Rules, The Revenue Department under the Guidance of Directorate of Public Participation shall hold consultative meetings with the business community and representatives of stakeholder organizations within their areas of jurisdiction once in every year.
